



Stormwater Pollution Prevention

Restaurants

Stormwater pollution is not only costly but can also be a nuisance, causing:

- *Flooding* - of property from grease/garbage poured into & blocking storm drains.
- *Rodents & Pests* - attracted to grease/garbage in & around storm drains.
- *Foul Odors* - from wash water, waste, & grease poured into storm drains.

Anything poured or pushed into a storm drain goes directly to local lakes & streams without treatment.

It is a violation of City Ordinance to place materials of any kind in City streets or storm drains.



- Educate employees on preventing stormwater pollution.
- Properly dispose of grease in designated containers.
- Close lids, doors, & drain plugs on waste containers.
- Sweep around exterior grease/garbage containers.
- Cleanup spills using dry cleaning/sweeping methods.



- Pour or push grease or garbage into a storm drain.
- Pour wash water onto the ground outside.
- Wash floor mats or kitchen equipment outside.
- Sweep or wash materials out the door.
- Dispose of liquids in the garbage.
