



## Hydrant Meter Rental Application

Hydrant meters are intended for temporary construction purposes and other temporary uses as approved by Lee's Summit Water Utilities. Rentals will be made based on availability and in accordance to applicable City Ordinances.

- I understand and agree to the following conditions for rental of a hydrant meter:
- I assume responsibility for all charges associated with the rental of the hydrant meter which include a Deposit, a daily rental fee and all water consumed. See page 2 for fees and charges. NOTE: Fees & charges are subject to change.
- I agree to supply monthly meter readings to Lee's Summit Water Utilities by either telephone or email as listed below. The reading shall be provided between the 20th and the 25th of each month.
- I agree to return the hydrant meter and all associated equipment provided at the time of rental in good condition to the Water Utilities Service Center, 1200 SE Hamblen Road, Lee's Summit, MO 64081.
- I agree that should the hydrant meter or associated equipment fail during the rental period, I agree to return the meter to the City of Lee's Summit for testing and repair. The Lee's Summit Water Utilities Department shall have two (2) business days to test and repair the meter.
- I agree to be liable for any damage or loss to the hydrant meter and associated equipment and for any repairs that are necessary due to damage or loss.
- I agree to pay all hydrant meter charges by the bill due date during the rental period. I further understand that if my account exceeds thirty (30) days in delinquency that the hydrant meter may be confiscated and subject to forfeiture of the deposit.
- I agree to return the hydrant meter and any associated equipment at the request of the Lee's Summit Water Utilities Department. All hydrant meter agreements shall be terminated on December 1st and all hydrant meters shall be returned. The Utility will determine if weather conditions or other factors allow for rental of hydrant meters during the winter period as prescribed by City Ordinance 32-102.

**Hydrant Meter Charges and Rental Information**

**DEPOSIT**

Deposits are assessed based on the size of the Hydrant Meter:

- 3/4" Meter     \$200
- 2" Meter       \$500

Billed and due on first bill.

**ACCOUNT ACTIVATION**

Fee to establish new accounts - \$10

**BILLING CYCLE**

Hydrant Meters are billed the 7th of each month and due on 28th.

**DAILY RENTAL CHARGE**

Hydrant Meter rental charges have a daily charge of:

- 3/4" Meter     \$5.00/day
- 2" Meter       \$10.00/day

**VOLUMETRIC CHARGE**

All water consumed - \$5.02 per 1,000 gallons

**MINIMUM USAGE REQUIREMENTS**

Hydrant Meters have a minimum usage requirement based on the size of the meter:

- 3/4" Meter     100 gallons per day
- 2" Meter       250 gallons per day

**EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT**


When a Hydrant Meter is returned, the unit will be inspected for its condition. If any damages are found beyond normal use, Water Utilities staff will determine the nature of the repairs necessary. Costs will be based on current contract prices as applicable. Labor for all repairs will be at \$35/hr with a minimum of 1 hour.
